



Cascades Futurity & Aged Event

LAE RULES & REGULATIONS

Redmond, Or.

August 14-22, 2021

1. **Judges:** A five (5) Judge system will be used. Horses will be scored under NCHA Rules. All owners & riders must be current members of NCHA.
2. **Registration Certificate:** Required on all horses. Proof in the form of a photocopy of the registration certificate or a notarized statement of age & description must be submitted with all entries. No horses will be entered into the draw without copy of certificate.
3. **Entries:** Entries are due & payable in full by August 2, 2021. Any entry not postmarked by August 2nd will be assessed a late fee. Open division will be assessed a late fee of \$175. Non-Pro division will be assessed a late fee of \$100. Amateur divisions will be assessed a late fee of \$100. Unlimited number of entries per owner and/or rider will be accepted.
4. **NCHA Membership:** Both owner & riders must be current NCHA members.
5. **Stall Fees:** Will be \$190 including stall mats due on August 2, 2021. All stall reservations not postmarked on or before August 2, 2021 will be charged \$215. Stall availability are not guaranteed after August 2, 2021.
6. **Ties:** If any two riders tie for the championship of any class, co-champions shall be declared. First & second place monies will be divided equally. The highest accumulative score of the two go rounds and the finals will determine awards. Three way or greater ties shall be worked off with one being determined as champion and remainder as co-reserve champions. The money will be split equally.
7. **Gelding & Senior Divisions:** Within all Open, Non-Pro and Amateur divisions, a Gelding division will be held. Within all Non-Pro and Amateur divisions, a Senior division will be held. (Senior age is 60 years old.) Payout will be made to the furthestmost advancing 25% of entries. The Gelding and Senior classes are a class within a class. There is not a separate final.
8. **Eligibility:**
 - **Horses:** There will be three (3) limited aged groups: Futurity (3-year-olds), Derby (4-year-olds) and Classic Challenge (5/6 year-old.) The Derby and Classic Challenge divisions will have three (3) main divisions within each and each division will have an Intermediate.
 - **Divisions:** The divisions are: Open, Non-Pro, Amateur
 - **Revolving Door:**
 - If a rider is NOT in the Top 100 money earning NCHA riders for the previous two point year in ANY division, they may drop back into the Intermediate level.
 - **Senior Exception:** Once a rider turns 70, the rider can drop down into the Intermediate level regardless of earnings.

9. **Rider Eligibility:**

- a. **Enter:** A rider may enter any level or levels in which they are eligible.

10. **Go Round/Finals Advancement for Derby and Classic:**

- All Open top-level divisions of the Derby and Classic Challenge are two go round and a final.
- All Open Intermediate levels in the Derby and Classic Challenge will go within the 2nd go round of the Open.
- 25% of the horses competing in the Open and Open Intermediate within their age group will advance to finals.
- All Non-Pro and Amateur Top & Intermediate level divisions are one go round and a final.
- 30% of the horses competing in the Non-Pro, Intermediate Non-Pro, Amateur and Intermediate Amateur within their age group will advance to the finals.
- All monies paid out in the finals. All finalists will receive a check.
- Must have 14 entered to have a final. Finals will be a minimum of 5 and maximum of 25 entries plus ties in the finals. **ANY DIVISION WITH LESS THAN 14 HORSES WILL BE A PENCIL FINALS.**

11. **Open Futurity & Intermediate Open Futurity:** The Futurity Open and Intermediate Open Futurity will be held in three separate shows. Number of horses paid based on NCHA payout. **All horses must be entered in the Open.** The intermediate is a class within the Open. The added money for the Open Futurity is \$6,200 per class. The added money for the Open Futurity Intermediate is \$1,700 per class. The fee for the Open Futurity is \$750 (Ef\$400, Cc \$250, Of/Video \$100) per class. There is no additional fee to enter in the Intermediate. The purse will be made up of the jackpot money of \$400 which will be split 80/20 – 80% going to the Open and 20% to the Intermediate plus the respective added monies. Those qualifying to be in the Intermediate class will have two chances to earn money – from the Open purse and also from the Intermediate purse. There will be an Open Futurity Circuit Champion and Open Reserve Futurity Champion and also an Open Intermediate Champion and Reserve Champion based on the highest accumulated money won. A horse must be shown two of the three times the class is offered. Buckles will be presented.

12. **Non-Pro Futurity and Intermediate Non-Pro Futurity:** The Non-Pro Futurity and Intermediate Non-Pro will consist of three separate shows. Number of horses paid based on NCHA payout. **All horses must be entered in the Non-Pro.** The Intermediate Non-Pro is a class within the Non-Pro. The added money for the Non-Pro Futurity is \$1,500 per class. The added money for the Non-Pro Intermediate Futurity is \$500 per class. The fee for the Non Pro class is \$650 (Ef\$300, Cc

\$250, Office/Video \$100) There is no additional fee to enter in the Intermediate Non-Pro. The purse will be made up of the \$300 jackpot fee split 80/20 – 80% going to the Non-Pro and 20% to the Intermediate Non-Pro plus the respective added monies. Those qualifying to be in the Intermediate class will have two chances to earn money – from the Non-Pro purse and also from the Intermediate purse. There will be a Non-Pro Circuit Champion and Reserve Non-Pro Champion and also an Intermediate Non-Pro Champion and Intermediate Non-Pro Reserve Champion based on the highest accumulated money won. A horse must be shown two of the three times the class is offered. Buckles will be presented.

13. **Ranch Raised Incentive:** As an added incentive to the Open Futurity and Non-Pro Futurity there will be the Ranch Raised. To qualify, the entry must have retained ownership of foal beginning with conception through show date. Entry fee is \$0 and winners to receive \$2,500.
14. **APHA Chrome Cash:** Cascades Futurity would like to recognize APHA performance horses in the APHA Chrome Cash. The APHA Chrome Cash will be held within the Derby Open.
15. **Advancement Fee:** There will be an advancement fee charged to all working finals of \$225 to cover finals cattle costs.
16. **Awards:** All working finalists will receive an award. Champion & Reserve Champion awards will be presented in all finals.
17. **Show Management Reserves the Right:** Show management reserves the right to make any changes, additions and deletions to these rules as deemed necessary by them. Notice of any changes will be posted at the show and/or upon request. Show management reserves the right to cancel said event or any classes within said event, without notice any time prior to the contest. In such event, fees pertaining to the class or the event, as the case may be, will be refunded.
18. **Refunds:** Any reasonable request for a refund will be granted up to 7 days prior to the event. After that date a valid veterinarian certificate must be presented to the office. A processing charge of \$100 will be retained.
19. **NSF Checks:** Individuals presenting Cascades Futurity with checks which cannot be redeemed for the full amount in cash are subject to appropriate legal processing and prosecution as well as expulsion from participating in cutting horse events. A \$50 fee will be charged to all NSF checks.
20. **Unpaid Bills:** Any show bill left unpaid at the conclusion of the event will be assessed 15% of the total outstanding amount.
21. **Fees / Show Bill Disputes:** Any dispute concerning fees and/or payments must be made with the show secretary within 30 days of the last show date otherwise **ALL FEES are due and payable.**
